Minimum Age: 18

Expenses

Due to funding given to support development of skills in people under 25 you may be eligible to receive help towards travel costs up to £5 per day.

Training Given

Successful applicants will receive induction training (including introduction to safeguarding and health and safety) before the week commences and day-to-day training and mentoring when in the role.
