

# Welcome to Logan Botanic Garden

Logan's almost island-like setting at the south western tip of Scotland allows the Garden to enjoy maximum benefit from the warming influence of the Gulf Stream. The mild conditions permit an array of over 5,000 different species of trees, shrubs, herbs and bulbs from warm temperate regions of the world, especially the southern hemisphere, to flourish here for your enjoyment.

## Explore

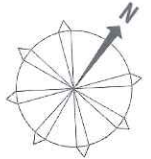
This map will allow you to wander at your own pace around the two contrasting areas of this remarkable Garden:

**The Walled Garden:** the historic heart of the Garden, sheltered by 15 foot high walls, including a surviving fragment of medieval Castle Balzieland, and enclosing rolling lawns, water gardens, groves of tree ferns and palms, a rock gully, terraces, a verandah, and the world's first peat wall garden - each zone displaying spectacular exotic species of plants.

**The Woodland Garden:** developed from open fields in the last 40 years, this site rises on the south and west sides of the Walled Garden. The woodland slopes showcase the famous Gunnera Bog, Tasmanian Creek plantings, and a series of maturing woodland glades that evoke parts of New Zealand, Chile and New South Wales in Australia.

**Logan Conservatory:** this three zone Glasshouse, beside the Walled Garden, is being planted with an array of exotic species that need this extra protection.

To enhance your visit pick up an Audio Tour, or Souvenir Guidebook from visitor reception, or join one of the regular guided tours by the Curator and his staff.
