# Logan

## Botanic Garden

**Take a walk into paradise at Logan Botanic Garden, also known as 'Scotland's Most Exotic Garden'. Located on the south-west tip of Scotland and warmed by the Gulf Stream, this is a beautiful five-star Garden where plants from South and Central America, Southern Africa, Australia and New Zealand flourish.**



On arrival, summer visitors are greeted with a riot of colour and unusual scents in the Walled Garden, a showcase for exotic plants. The fishpond, adorned with water lilies, adds to the air of tranquillity.

The Garden's avenues and borders feature a fascinating array of half-hardy perennials, many native to the southern hemisphere. Visitors can walk through groves of eucalyptus and palm trees or stand in the shade of awesome giant rhubarb-like *Gunnera* plants.

The elegant Victorian-style Logan Conservatory houses tender exotic plants from South Africa, which are a delight to see. The Conservatory is the first 'all green greenhouse in the UK' and the Garden has been awarded gold from the Green Tourism scheme.

As part of this package, you will enjoy a tour with a Logan Guide who will point out the Garden's botanical treasures. This visit will fascinate garden and plant enthusiasts, and is also ideal for those who simply want to stroll in natural surroundings or relax and enjoy the peace and quiet.

You may wish to simply relax and enjoy the view from The Potting Shed Bistro where you can enjoy the delights of a traditional Scottish afternoon tea. Afterwards, why not, wander around the exhibition space or browse in the nature-inspired shop?

The Royal Botanic Garden Edinburgh, founded in 1670, is a world renowned centre for plant research, conservation and education. Its four remarkable Gardens – the “Botanics” in Edinburgh; the mountain-side Benmore in Argyll; Dawyck in the wooded hills of the Scottish Borders; and Logan on a Gulf Stream warmed peninsula in Galloway – differ in topography, soils and climate, enabling an exceptionally wide range of plants to be grown. Together they constitute one of the richest plant collections on Earth, with more than 15,000 species in cultivation.
