Learning Intentions

Children will:

- Observe variety in plants, their leaves and flowers
- Make drawings from live materials in our Garden or glasshouses
- Learn about and use an art technique
- Create an art work using the art technique

What to expect

A general introduction to the Garden and the importance of plants will lead into an outline/description of the class' activities for the day. Children will do observational drawings from plants in the Garden or glasshouses. They will be introduced to the basic techniques used in the chosen art-form and then use these techniques to create their own masterpiece. Appropriate clothing and shoes should be worn for possible outdoor work.
