This quest will take children on a journey into the tropical rainforest to help us solve a puzzle while finding and learning about key rainforest plants.

Learning Intentions

Children will:

- Understand that many foods and other products originate in the rainforest and not the supermarket
- Use their senses to learn that the climate and habitat in the rainforest is different to that of Scotland
