### Job Description

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Directly support Senior Research Horticulturist in all designated areas of cultivation of potted collections.
- Day to day management of *Woodsia ilvensis* fern collection to directly support PhD project and Target 8 conservation ex-situ collections.
- Daily maintenance of shade tunnel and adjacent potted plants, all aspects of cultivation.
- Directly support the maintenance and potting of research Zingiberaceae collection
- Fern spore/seed cleaning and cataloguing
- Absence cover for daily maintenance of planted areas within the Gateway Visitor Centre, and assist with rotation of display plants as required.
- Support public display glasshouse staff, as required, in pruning, watering, weeding, and developing landscapes to ensure the highest standards are met for visitors
- Absence cover within the Department as required
- BGBase record-keeping; stocktaking and labelling
- P&D monitoring in areas of responsibility
- Work with HND1 Students for weekly work experience programme and Interns

### **Specific Responsibilities**

- Potting up of *Woodsia ilvensis* collection; part of our ex-situ conservation programme and provide support to PhD student (circa 1800 individual plants)
- Re-potting of fern collection in shade tunnel
- Stock check of the research *Begonia socotrana* and *B. samhaensis* collections and self-pollination of single clones to obtain fresh seed for the germplasm bank.
