# Post: RHS Course Co-ordinator and Tutor Department: Education Division: Horticulture and Learning

## Job Description

#### General Responsibilities and Information about the Post

To teach students on RHS Level 2 and 3 courses; to manage the RHS Level 2 attended course and assist with the day to day running and administration of RHS level 2 and 3 courses online; to develop new online materials and implement improvements to existing courses.

#### About RHS courses at RBGE

RBGE is one of 5 approved RHS online distance learning providers enabling UK and international students to study for an RHS qualification. RBGE also provides this course to attended students. The RHS Level 2 Principles of Horticulture Certificate is RBGE's flagship online course and this post will involve continuing the development of RBGE's RHS offer.

### About PropaGate Learning

PropaGate Learning is RBGE's online learning platform which uses the Moodle software. It gives students access to RBGE's tutors, a community of like-minded learners and a world renowned garden.

PropaGate Learning is a unique blend of online and attended learning, building on over 300 years of teaching at the Garden and now uses the latest technologies giving learners a sociable and flexible route to recognised qualifications.

Currently PropaGate Learning hosts RHS level 2 and RHS Level 3 qualifications, RBGE Certificates and Diplomas, along with some shorter courses.

You will working closely with the small PropaGate Learning team as well as the wider Education department at RBGE.





### **Specific Responsibilities**

- Plan and co-ordinate the teaching of the attended RHS level 2 Principles of Horticulture certificate and study weekends for the online course
- Teach on the attended RHS level 2 Principles of Horticulture certificate course and study weekends for online students
- Ensure the teaching resources for the online and attended RHS level 2 Principles of Horticulture certificate and the online RHS Level 3 Certificate 1 in the Principles of Plant Growth, Health and Applied Propagation match the Learning Outcomes
- Support RHS online students by answering questions about the syllabus and exam questions together with keeping them on track
- Work with the Online Learning Manager to review online courses and make improvements
- Work with the PropaGate Learning Team and other tutors to develop and update resources for RHS online courses, specifically for the second RHS level 2 certificate: 'Principles of Garden Planning, Establishment and Maintenance'
- Review the RHS Level 3 Certificate and make updates where necessary
- Carry out actions from the RHS audits
