A Walk Through the Centuries

From The Botanics', where guests will meet their guide at 10 am, transportation will take the group to where it all began back in 1670 with the Physic Garden at Holyrood. A gentle walk, taking in significant horticultural places of interest along the way brings the guests back to the Inverleith site. The experience concludes with lunch back at the Gateway Restaurant at around 1 pm. Approximately 4 hour experience

This experience can accommodate upwards of 2 guests, with guideline prices as:
